This supplement (the “**Supplement**”) is prepared by Nationwide Building Society (the “**Issuer**”) and supplements the base prospectus dated 1 August 2025 for the European Note Programme, as previously supplemented on 20 November 2025, 16 December 2025, 9 April 2026 and 21 May 2026 (the “**Base Prospectus**”).

This Supplement constitutes (i) a supplement to the Base Prospectus for the purposes of Article 23 of the UK Prospectus Regulation and (ii) supplementary admission particulars to the Base Prospectus for the European Note Programme as it comprises admission particulars for the purposes of the ISM Rulebook (and references herein to the Base Prospectus shall include such document as it comprises such admission particulars for the purposes of the ISM Rulebook).

This Supplement is supplemental to, and should be read in conjunction with, the Base Prospectus and any other supplements thereto published by the Issuer. Terms defined in the Base Prospectus and not defined in this Supplement have the same meaning when used in this Supplement.

The Issuer accepts responsibility for the information contained in this Supplement. To the best of the knowledge of the Issuer, the information contained in this Supplement is in accordance with the facts and this Supplement makes no omission likely to affect its import.

This Supplement has been approved as a supplement to the Base Prospectus by the Financial Conduct Authority (the “**FCA**”), as competent authority under the UK Prospectus Regulation. The FCA only approves this Supplement as meeting the standards of completeness, comprehensibility and consistency imposed by the UK Prospectus Regulation. Such approval should not be considered as an endorsement of the Issuer or the quality of the Notes that are the subject of this Supplement (“**Notes**”) and the Base Prospectus. Investors should make their own assessment as to the suitability of investing in any Notes issued under the European Note Programme.

A copy of this Supplement has also been submitted to the London Stock Exchange plc (the “**London Stock Exchange**”) in connection with the application for Exempt Notes issued under the European Note Programme to be admitted to trading on the International Securities Market (the “**ISM**”) of the London Stock Exchange. The London Stock Exchange has not approved or verified the contents of this Supplement.

PURPOSE OF THIS SUPPLEMENT

The purpose of this Supplement is to:

- (b) update the ‘*Material Change*’ statement in the Base Prospectus.
