PRICING SUPPLEMENT

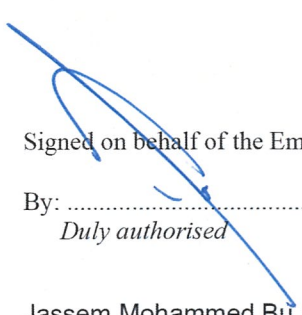
