European Raw Materials Alliance Supports GreenRoc Mining Amitsoq Graphite Project In Greenland

To Whom it May Concern,

GreenRoc Mining Plc ('GreenRoc') and the European Raw Material Alliance ('ERMA') announce the ERMA's official support for the Amitsoq graphite project in Greenland.

The Amitsoq graphite project in southern Greenland is one of the highest-grade graphite deposits globally. GreenRoc has recently announced a 2023 mineral resource estimate for the Amitsoq island deposit comprising a total inferred, indicated, and measured JORC resource of 23.05 Mt at an average grade of 20.41% graphitic carbon. Independent test work has confirmed that it can be upgraded to high-purity spherical graphite (>99.95% C) for use in lithium-ion batteries and the electric vehicle sector.

GreenRoc's graphite resource is of global importance and together with the company's strategy will enable the European Union to achieve a certain level of independence for the electrical vehicle supply chain. ERMA has approved the Amitsoq graphite project and will engage to support its development to produce these critical raw materials for the benefit of the European Union goals.
